It is against the law to make alcohol available to anyone younger than 21 even with their parent's permission. If it happens in your home, you'll pay for what happens outside your home.

Making alcoholic beverages available to a minor is a Class A Misdemeanor punishable by:

- **A fine up to \$4,000; and/or**
- **Confinement in jail for up to a year;**
 - **Automatic suspension of driver's license for 180 days upon conviction.**
